- o Any partnership with the City is zero for zero with projects like these
- Murals depict the frustration with the gentrification in RiNo and Santa Fe
- RiNo is a failure because it's rich people branding it the way they want to, not addressing the history
- Until we own real estate, we are vulnerable
- Any conversation for branding needs to be coupled with how we get renters and owners to be able to stay in the neighborhood
- No one controls the market
- Lease negotiations training at an upcoming meeting
- The Fax helped with Brothers development with a focus on affordable housing
- City needs to "buy the block"
- No one is addressing parking
- Mission Statement Option 1
 - Don't like option one
 - RiNo and Santa Fe
 - Retain ownership
 - Too Capitalistic



- Mission Statement Option 2
 - Like "By empowering businesses"
 - Ending is more clunky
- Self-realization for retention
- Relocation funding from the City isn't enough when displacing businesses
- Improve mission statement and circulate for final wordsmithing
