2nd Annual East Colfax Cultural District Community Field Day



On Saturday June 21st the second annual East Colfax Cultural District Community Field Day was held. Building on the success of last year's Field Day, the Cultural District's Steering Committee, in conjunction with The Fax Partnership, returned to the wonderful Mosaic Campus to welcome over 250 residents young and old, and fill their afternoon with games, music, and thankfully - given the heat - 18 gallons of ice cream from local businesses Nuggs and Little Man.

With games to play and prizes to be won, kids ran from station to station, making sure to catch some of the spray from the Denver Fire Department's truck that did double duty as an attraction and respite from heat. Denver Love Goats returned for a 2nd year, while music from Upbeat Colorado filled the air, ranging from classical to kids songs that got the crowd involved and on stage. This year an art market was added to the event, showcasing local artists works and highlighting the diversity and creativity that are intrinsic to East Colfax.

The event concluded with kids and adult ice cream eating contests and a raffle of prizes donated from an array of local institutions and businesses including: The Denver Museum of Natural History and Science, The Colorado Ballet, Coors Brewery, Casa Bonita, Tiger Kim's Martial Arts Academy, and The Denver Nuggs.

East Colfax Residential Survey: 5 Year Follow-Up

In 2020 The Fax conducted a residential survey to learn from the community. A lot has changed in the intervening 5 years and even more change is on the horizon with the East Colfax Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) project already underway and progressing East along Colfax.



The BRT construction will result in an increase in traffic and disruption, and there will be businesses that close. This has already been seen further west on Colfax. While the the rapid bus line will make Colfax more open

and accessible in the future, it's imperative to lay the groundwork to ensure that those who call East Colfax home will be able to enjoy the benefits of this project once complete.

By completing this survey, residents of East Colfax and neighboring communities, will be able to highlight what they value in the community and what they hope to see strengthen it in the years to come. The results of the survey will help guide The Fax's work in these critical upcoming years. The results will be anonymous and will be shared with non-profit and governmental partners to ensure the community's voice is heard.
